

Getting from LISBON to TOMAR (and from TOMAR to LISBON)

Lisbon Airport

You can take a taxi from Lisbon Airport to Orient Station (Estação do Oriente) – it takes about 10 minutes. The taxis are just outside the airport and to the station the fare varies between €4 and €8 depending on the traffic.

Opposite Orient Station are the Vasco da Gama Shopping Mall and the Nations Park (Parque das Nações), where the Expo '98 was held – a very pleasant setting by the Tagus River with buildings with specific themes, like the Science Pavilion and the Oceanarium, and also restaurants and gardens.

Orient Station

There are trains departing Lisbon (Orient Gare) to Tomar about every hour. The whole journey takes about 2 hours (you can get a single ticket direct to Tomar, between €7 and €9, for further information about ticket prices please consult the Portuguese Railway Service website at www.cp.pt -- for the English version please click on the English flag).

Observations:

- Trains marked * do not circulate on weekends (Saturdays and Sundays)
- Trains marked ** do not circulate on Sundays
- Trains marked + are faster trains and as such a bit more expensive

Tomar Station

You can take a taxi from Tomar station to the Templários Hotel, Santa Marta Residencial Hotel or the students' halls of residence (about 5 minutes' journey). The Trovador, Sinagoga and Cavaleiros Residencial Hotels, are about a 5 minute walk.

There are taxis outside the railway station and at the city centre (5 minutes' walk). There is a standard fare of about €5 including luggage. You can also use the special public transport [TuTomar](#).
